5 Key Budget Categories Every Municipality Should Plan For

1 Hardware Refresh & Lifecycle Planning

Replace aging computers, servers, and networking gear before failure disrupts operations. Plan on a 5-year refresh cycle and document replacement dates to avoid surprise expenses.

2 Cybersecurity & Compliance

Cyber threats are growing, and municipalities are frequent targets. Budget for:

- Multifactor authentication (MFA)
- Endpoint protection & email security
- Employee cybersecurity training
- Regular security assessments

Tip: Prevention costs far less than recovery.

3 Data Backup & Disaster Recovery

Ask: 'If our server room burned down, how fast could we be back online?' Include reliable offsite and cloud backups that are tested regularly, and ensure you have a written recovery plan.

4 Cloud & Software Licensing

Account for annual increases in software subscriptions such as Microsoft 365, accounting systems, or GIS tools. Track renewal dates and plan 12 months ahead to avoid service gaps or surprise costs.

5 Strategic IT Planning & Support

Technology isn't a one-time purchase — it's an ongoing service. Include funds for:

- Managed IT support (help desk, monitoring, updates)
- Quarterly strategic reviews
- Future project planning (network upgrades, security improvements)

This keeps your technology aligned with long-term community goals.

Common Budgeting Mistakes to Avoid

Even well-run municipalities can stumble when planning technology budgets. Avoid these pitfalls:

- ✗ Waiting until budget season to assess IT needs
- ✗ Underestimating cybersecurity risks
- ✗ Leaving IT decisions to non-technical staff
- ✗ Treating technology as a cost instead of a strategic investment
